Below are 8 questions that you may choose to use for a recap exercise. The purpose of this exercise being to test the learner and to see how much they have learnt in the session. Tutors will need to exercise a little discretion with regards to the answers the learners give. Possible answers to each question are listed.

1	Can you define volunteering?	Spending time doing something that assists others.
2	What benefits can volunteering bring to a uniformed organisation? Can you name at least 2	Provide expertise; provide time; provide extra help; provide new ideas; respond in an emergency, raise funds.
3	What benefits do volunteers gain from volunteering? Can you name at least 2	Gain new life skills, develop existing skills, diversity awareness.
4	Can you name at least 4 volunteer roles within the uniformed organisations?	Police: Special Constables British Army: reservists Fire and Rescue: Volunteer firefighters First Aid society: St John RAF: reservists Cadet Forces Adult Volunteer
5	Volunteers may receive allowances or payments for their work. True or false?	True
6	What commitment would an Army reservist have to give?	1 x 2hr training evening per week, a training weekend per month and a 2 week annual camp.
7	Can you name at least 4 volunteering opportunities that cadets can take part in throughout the year?	Could include: helping at cadets, organising fundraising events, Red Cross Emergency Responders, St John, working in community, working in animal sanctuary, working with people with disabilities, youth work, visiting elderly people, taking part in an organised event or street collecting.
8	Volunteering is a key element for cadets working towards what award?	Duke of Edinburgh Award
